

Taking medicine safely



It is important to follow your healthcare provider's directions when you take your medicines. You may want to ask a friend or family member to help.

These tips can help you take your medicines safely.



At your doctor's office

- Make a list of all the medicines you are taking, take it to each doctor visit and share it with your doctor.
- Tell or show your healthcare provider every medicine you take, including herbs, vitamins, and supplements.
- Ask what to do if you miss a dose.
- Ask about side effects for each medicine you take and what to do if you have a side effect.
- Ask if you should avoid certain foods, drinks, activities, or other medicines.
- Tell your healthcare provider if you are allergic to any medicines.



At your pharmacy

- Check the label on your prescription container or packaging when you pick it up.
- Make sure it has your name and is the right medicine and dose.
- Ask how to take your medicine and if there are any special instructions. Repeat them back to your pharmacist.



At home

- Take each medicine as directed by your healthcare provider. Do not skip doses, cut pills in half, or take extra.
- Make a list of your medicines, how much you take, and how to take them. Keep a copy in your wallet.
- Do not stop taking your medicine unless your doctor tells you to.
- Call your doctor if you have a side effect.
- Read the written information that comes with your medicine. Call your healthcare provider or pharmacist if you don't understand.
- Ask a family member or friend to help you keep track of your medicines.



In the hospital or healthcare setting

- Make sure your healthcare providers check your wristband and ask your name before giving you medicine.
- Make sure you get all of your medicines at the right time. Ask if you are not sure.
- If you are given a new medicine, ask if it is safe to take with your other medicines.
- After you leave, ask the doctor you see regularly to take a look at any new medicine you were given at the hospital.

Ask for help to manage your medicines
